

## NOTICE

Cinisello Balsamo, like many cities in Italy and in the world, introduced the City Tax Living for tourists and visitors who stay there.

The amount varies from  $\notin$  0,50 to  $\notin$  2,00 for every night, depending on the type and number of stars of the structure, by resolution of the City Council no. 59 of 26/03/2015.

The structure is required to issue a separate receipt for the amount paid or to indicate on the invoice the sum corresponding to the City Tax Living.

Staffs are required to provide all information related to the categories exempted from the payment.

The revenue will finance interventions to preserve the historical and cultural heritage of the city and improve the services offered to all tourists.

## EXEMPTIONS

Are exempted from payment:

1. Minors;

2. Family members and / or related or other carers of patients in healthcare facilities in the territory of the Metropolitan City of Milan, up to a maximum of two and only for the period of hospitalization;

3. Those that following hospitalization continuing care at health facilities in the territory of the Metropolitan City of Milan, and their companions, up to a maximum of two for patient;

4. The staff belonging to State or Local Police, the other armed forces, as well as the national Fire Department, for reasons of their service;

5. Volunteers coordinated by the Civil Protection staying in accommodation as a result of measures taken by public authorities, to tackle natural disasters;

6. The coach drivers and tour leaders who provide assistance to groups driven by travel agencies and tourism. The exemption applies to every coach driver and a tour guide for every twenty members.
