## 2. Our network as an extended learning hub

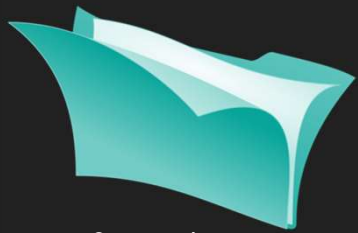
- training projects are **100%** realized within the municipalities

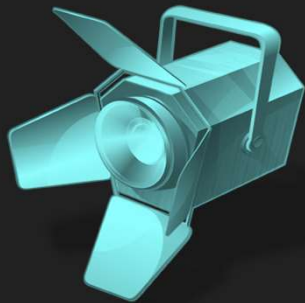

# 4. Non-formal education as a way of bringing young people closer to the job market

**Training on the job +**

3 to 12 months experience

**Training in classroom**

12 courses /1 day each

**+ Exam, certificate**

Monitored by a regional standard, standard diploma



## 5. Results

On January 2016 the survey was conducted on a base of 550 trainees, which ended the training at least 12 months before.

### **Was the training in the municipality useful to find a job?**

- 90% of the interviewed found the experience useful to enrich the CV
- 25% met external partners, with whom they established professional relationships
- 12% met people which introduced them to the job market

**38% of the youngsters which were involved in our training programs experienced a change of status within a year from the end of the program: from unemployed, to employed.**

## 5. Results

In the end we asked the trainees:

**Would you like to work for your Common?**

62% said yes.

**Would you be actively involved in local politics?**

70% said they are not interested in active role in politics.  
And this is another issue we have to work on.
