The CAE gathers people who want to create their job in a collective framework.

Both an incubator and a shared company owned by its members

A CAE, a key player in local economic development.

The 1st CAE was created in 1995. CO-ACTIONS was created in 2004

Legal framework since 2014 « Social Economy Law »

Co-Actions supports the entrepreneurs in experimenting the viability of their own business project with safety, freedom, solidarity, and taking part in the life of the social enterprise.

This model is a source of capacity building for the people and for their potential of creativity and innovation



The cooperative isn't specialized in a specific sector: we have 25 different professions





consultants cookers trainers photographers artisans urban gardeners web programmers designers yoga teacher etc.





Each of us gives a financial participation to pay the permanent support staff.

These support staff help us **to develop our business**, our competencies, **handle the administrative part** and **accounting**. There are **9 members** of support staff (the equivalent of about 5 full time people).

We have **an online platform** to do the **quotes** and **invoices** for our customers, our **expense accounts** and our colleague who is an accountant manages all the administrative parts and tax payments. As entrepreneurs, we could be focused on the development part of our activity











2. How does it work?


Entrepreneur Path in the CAE

Concretely, when a project leader joins the cooperative **he's supported by different people** to develop and work on his **business ideas**, identify his **targets**, **costs** and **prices**, to determine his **communication strategy**, etc. He has a **coach/adviser** to support them as often as necessary.

So the process is, you have an idea, you join the cooperative, you start to develop your business and have contracts and when you have **sufficient business results**, you could become **an employee** and have the status of "associate-employee-entrepreneur" because you are a shareholder of the cooperative (you buy shares).

2. How does it work? Cooperative Life

The support staff organise **different cooperative seminars** during the year to allow the entrepreneurs to meet them, to talk, to participate in the strategic development of the CAE.









3. Social innovation in action

- Creating local jobs in rural and urban zones
- → The **same rights as the employees** of any enterprises (social protection, individual training rights, unemployment benefits, etc).
- → A collective entrepreneurship project: the entrepreneur could actively contribute in the cooperative life and its strategic development: a real shared governance enterprise
- Diversity of exchanges, cooperation, partnerships, networking

3. Social innovation in action

- → Today, the CAE aims not only to secure the job and individual business creation, it is also an alternative to build a collective entrepreneurship project.
- → By investing themselves in the long term, the employees-entrepreneurs **contribute** in the development of the collective and cooperative project **on a human and financial way.**
- → The cooperative has a **small turn over** and has a scale development which allows the necessary self financing for its construction.
- → This collective project and its mechanism of sharing aim to offer higher work conditions that would not be possible as a freelancer:
 - sharing offices
 - cooperation between entrepreneurs
 - mutual communication and sales strategy
 - forecast cash needs, etc.

- ✓ Tiers-Lieux = Third places = The place that is not home and not work
- ✓ Tiers-Lieux are all the places like coworking spaces, fablab, maker space etc
- ✓ Co-actions created different coworking spaces to allow the enterpreneurs to have sharing places to meet partners, customers, colleagues and exchanges skills, contacts, ideas.

- ✓ Creation of 2 Tiers-Lieux in rural zone and 1 in urban zone
- ✓ Users of 2 Tiers-Lieux in urban zone
- ✓ Founder member of the regional network Tiers-Lieux Coopérative





Nearly 150 spaces at the regional level

Since 2013, CO-ACTIONS created

- a coworking space in Hagetmau, a small village in the south of the region, in a rural zone. This coworking space is located in the office of a large non for profit organization. The coworkers are local entrepreneurs and a small publishing house of poetry.
- a coworking space in La Réole another village in a rural zone. The cowoking space is open for all the **entrepreneurs of this region** and the **remote workers** (the employees that are allowed to work at home some days in a week).
- a coworking space in Bègles a small city close to Bordeaux in a sharing building with a grocery cooperative





In all these spaces, our cooperative organizes some information meetings to speak about the entrepreneurship in a cooperative framework, training sessions, or informal meeting like breakfast between entrepreneurs and local partners on a monthly basis.

The trainings are for example

- How to run a business in a cooperative
- Communication strategy
- Business models, etc.



The Tiers-Lieux Coop is the **regional network** of the "sharing spaces" that we created with other partners.

The motto of the Tiers-Lieux Coop is "working differently". This network aims to technically support all the third places and project leaders who have a project of coworking, fab lab or maker space. The Tiers-Lieux Cooperative organises also a specific training for the Tiers-Lieux facilitators.
