Il Comune di Cinisello Balsamo, Anci Lombardia, AnciLab, l'Agenzia Nazionale per i Giovani e la Rete Europea Intercity Youth hanno il piacere presentare la quinta InterCity Youth Conference dal titolo "**YOUTH WORK – LEARNING FOR LIFE, LEARNING FOR LABOUR**". Il tema che guiderà i lavori della conferenza sarà: quale è il collegamento tra le competenze sviluppate attraverso lo Youth Work e le competenze utili all'inserimento lavorativo dei giovani. In plenaria e nei gruppi di lavoro si confronteranno operatori ed esperti provenienti da diversi paesi europei. Lo Youth Work ha connessioni con il mondo del lavoro? Se sì perché? Come? Quali sono le evidenze che lo dimostrano? In che senso è collegato al Mercato del Lavoro? Quali sono le attenzioni e le competenze che lo youth worker dovrebbe maggiormente mettere in campo oggi? Infine, nel panorama italiano tra le figure professionali che operano con/per i giovani sta cambiando qualcosa? Chi sono gli youth worker oggi in Italia? L'iniziativa si rivolge ad amministratori, responsabili di area, operatori giovanili, ricercatori, decisori ed esperti che operano negli o per gli Enti Locali, ma la partecipazione è aperta anche ad operatori delle organizzazioni giovanili. Il primo giorno saranno protagoniste le politiche a favore dei giovani. Le politiche giovanili sono una sfida contemporanea? Se sì perché? In che modo? Esperti e operatori proveranno a dare una risposta confrontandosi anche con il punto di vista del mondo del lavoro. Il secondo giorno saranno protagonisti i giovani come elemento centrale per lo sviluppo e la crescita dei territori e delle città. Perchè i giovani sono considerati City Makers? Quali sono le evidenze e i casi emblematici in Italia come in Europa? Attraverso seminari di approfondimento e study visits in cui verranno presentati casi e approfonditi alcuni temi si cercherà di evidenziare il ruolo dei giovani ma al contempo le nuove figure professionali, le nuove competenze necessarie, i metodi migliori, per condurre processi di animazione territoriale che diano spazio di espressione alla creatività e competenza delle giovani generazioni. Il terzo giorno chiuderemo con la testimonianza di 3 grandi città italiane e un dibattito che metterà a confronto esperti di nazionalità europea e italiana sulle suggestioni emerse durante la conferenza ma anche sulle piste di lavoro future, provando a porre l'accento sulla dimensione europea della educazione non formale.

The Municipality of Cinisello Balsamo, Anci Lombardia, AnciLab, La Casa dei Comuni, Agenzia Nazionale per i Giovani and the Intercity Youth Network are glad to invite you to the 5<sup>th</sup> InterCity Youth Conference entitled "Youth Work – Learning for life, learning for labour" which will take place on the 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> of October 2016 in Cinisello Balsamo and in Milan. The leading subject of the conference will be the connection between the skills developed through the Youth Work and the skills useful to the integration of the young into employment. In the plenary assembly and in the working groups, operators and experts coming from different European countries will be discussing the subject. Has the Youth Work any connection with employment? If yes, why? How? What are the evidences? How is it connected to the Labour Market? What are the skills youth workers should mostly develop nowadays? Finally, is anything changing in Italy regarding the professionals operating with/for the young? Who are the youth workers nowadays in Italy? The event is intended for administrators, functional foremen, youth workers, researchers, decision makers and experts working in or for Local Bodies, but the participation is open also to workers of youth organizations. On the first day, the discussion will focus on the youth policies. Are youth policies a contemporary challenge? If yes, why? How? Experts and workers will try to find an answer discussing also with people of the labour market. On the second day, the discussion will focus on the young as a central element in the development and growth of territories and towns. Why are the young considered as City Makers? What are the evidences and the typical situations in Italy and Europe? Specific workshops and study visits illustrating situations and analyzing specific cases will try to point out the role of the young and, at the same time, the new professionals, the new skills which are requested and the best methods to give the young the opportunity to express their creativity and competencies. On the third day the works will end with the reports of three big Italian towns and a discussion among European and Italian experts on ideas and problems highlighted during the conference and on the next steps to take, underlining the European importance of non-conventional education.
